Job Summary:

The cleaning staff is responsible for ensuring that all cleaning tasks are completed conscientiously and according to the quality levels established by the Association. Cleaners are required to maintain cleanliness in all aspects to ensure that the YMCA facility meets or exceeds the expectations of members, volunteers, staff and visitors. The locations for this position are the Stratford YMCA on Downie St. and the St. Marys YMCA.

Responsibilities:

- Complete cleaning tasks as assigned for interior, exterior and back-of-house spaces
- Identify methods and products for routine tasks to achieve desired results
- Execute physical tasks such as lifting weight in excess of 20 pounds (e.g. furniture, garbage removal)
- Operation of vacuums, floor polishers, chemical cleaning agents and various tools
- Read and adhere to written safety instructions and standards related to specific cleaning tasks
- Communicate regularly with other departments (Health, Fitness and Aquatics, Child care, Membership Services) to ensure information is shared and up to date for all staff

Minimum Qualifications:

- 18 years old (minimum) or turning 18 during the 2020 calendar year
- Clear Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector Search
