- Maintaining First Aid Kit and contacting the Volleyball Co-ordinator for restocking
- Call games according to the official rules and regulations while tracking score on scoreboard
- Keep program spaces clean and free of debris
- Consulting with players re: ball inflation and occasionally best-of series length (for playoffs)
- Notifying the Volleyball Co-ordinator if unable to work a scheduled shift
